MCAPWA Public Works Leader of the Year

PURPOSE: The MCAPWA Public Works Leader of the Year program seeks to inspire excellence and dedication in public service by recognizing the outstanding career service achievements of individual public works professionals and officials. The primary focus of the award is on career service to the public works profession rather than on any one single event or project.

ELIGIBILITY: It is the intent of this award to recognize the career service accomplishments of Maine public works professionals and officials. Towards that end, candidates with a minimum of 10 years qualifying experience may be nominated from any of the following categories. The candidate must be in active service as of the year he or she is considered. APWA membership is not required. **Officers of the MCAPWA Board of Directors and members of the Awards Committee are not eligible during the time they serve in these positions.** Please note that individuals are only eligible to receive the Public Works Leader of the Year on one occasion.

CANDIDATES MAY COME FROM ANY OF THE THREE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

- A. Any non-elected, full-time employee of state, county or municipal government, that is responsible for one or more major divisions of a governmental agency. Most of the candidate's time and efforts must be devoted to the administration and management of the design, construction, maintenance and/or operation of a street or highway system, refuse collection or disposal system, public building, drainage or sewer system, or any other type of public works installation.
- B. Service in an appointed (non-elected) position on a board or commission charged with the oversight or policy level review of public works or infrastructure issues. Such service may have been at the state, county or municipal government level dealing with surface transportation systems, refuse, solid waste, and recycling systems, public buildings, drainage or sewers, or any other type of public works or infrastructure systems. Such positions may typically include City Manager; Public Works Commissioner or Board Member; Road Commissioner; Highway Commissioner; Transportation Commissioner; or other comparable position
- C. Elected officials who have prior qualifying experience from either category "A" or "B" may also be considered as candidates.

SELECTION: Is by a panel of judges appointed by the president of the MCAPWA Board of Directors. Membership of the panel represents the public works field and other agencies with an active interest in the public works profession.

NOMINATION PROCESS Any governmental entity, group, or individual may nominate candidates. Self-nominations are not accepted. APWA membership is not required. Original submittal should include nomination form and supporting documentation. It is encouraged that these materials be completed by the nominating party and not be left for the candidate to submit themselves. An electronic copy in PDF format or three hard copies of the submittal are required. These materials should be sent to MCAPWA. Materials submitted for supporting documentation will not be returned.

DEADLINE: September 13, 2019

PRESENTATION: The award winner is presented with a plaque during the Maine Chapter APWA 2019 Fall Meeting on October 3, 2019.

Community Service: List organizations, activities, offices held.

Awards: List educational, professional and civic awards. Include recognition for public service

A PDF or three hard copies of submittal are required. These materials should be sent to MCAPWA. The submittal and copies should include nomination form, supporting documentation and at least one original color photograph (headshot only) of the nominee. Letters of recommendation will be accepted providing each letter cites specific examples of professional involvement with the nominee. Letters will not be accepted after nomination deadline.
